POWER REQUIREMENTS:	Normal playing operation—200 watts. Peak 280 watts. Standby wattage (all lights on)— 50 watts.
RECORD SPEEDS PLAYED:	Conventional 78 r.p.m. Easily and quickly converted to 33½ or 45 r.p.m.
ACCUMULATOR:	New, improved type, electrically operated. Can be quickly adjusted from conventional play to six plays for 25¢, one play, 10¢, three plays, 25¢, one play, 5¢, three plays, 10¢.
COIN MECHANISM:	Single coin entry accommodates nickels, dimes, and quarters. Slug rejector quickly removable, without use of any tools. Large, over-size, pull-up type cash box with separate lock.
